Johann Michael Haydn (1737-1806), W.A. Mozart's friend and the younger brother of Joseph Haydn, was a concertmaster, court organist and teacher at the Salzburg court for 43 years. He wrote over 800 works – for the church, life at court and the theater. During the last years of his life he concentrated on composing music for songs, canons, lieder and vocal quartets intended to be sung with friends.

The Michael Haydn Museum will commemorate the master of sacred music in a small, impressive exhibition of pictures, scores, instruments and film/sound documents.

Prince-Archbishop Wolf Dietrich von Raitenau had the **Palace** built in 1606 as a token of his love for Salome Alt.

The marble staircase in baroque style, the **Angel Staircase**, with the charming putti (cherubs) and the sculptures by Georg Raphael Donner, is one of the most precious works of art at Mirabell Palace and can be visited daily from approx. 8 am-6 pm.

The **Marble Hall**, formerly the prince-archbishops' ballroom and concert venue for Leopold Mozart and his children Wolfgang and Nannerl, is considered to be one of the "most beautiful wedding halls in the world." Meetings, awards ceremonies and romantic concerts (Salzburg Palace Concerts) are held here regularly. Visits: Mon, Wed, Thu: 8 am - 4 pm, Tues + Fri: 1 - 4 pm. No visit in case of special occasions. Free entrance.

The other rooms house the municipal council and therefore not open to the public.

The **Mirabell Gardens**: they are a horticultural masterpiece, open daily from approx. 6 am to dusk.

The Hedge Theater: one of the oldest hedge theaters north of the Alps, closed during the winter.

Orangerie: open all year round, daily 9 am-4 pm, free entrance.

The **Dwarf Garden** features a number of misshapen creatures made of white Untersberg marble, closed during winter months.
